## **INTERNAL ASSESSMENT POLICY**

**( PROJECT/ PRACTICAL/ ACTIVITIES/ ALS)**

- The internal assessment will be based on the evidence and data collected through assignments, periodic tests, projects, practical etc. to determine a student's progress throughout the year.
- The assessment scheme will involve both, individual and team assessment and a mix of formative and summative assessment for promoting learning and development of students.
- The assessment policy will be based on the continuous and comprehensive evaluation with an emphasis on the holistic development of learners.

## BREAK-UP OF WEIGHTAGE FOR THE GRAND TOTAL (Per Subject)

The **Promotion Policy for class XI** will be based on the Grand Total (G.T), FOR EACH SUBJECT , which will include assessments, half-yearly examination and final examination (separately for Theory and Practical examination).

- 20% weightage of two best assessments out of three
- 20% weightage of half-yearly examination
- 60% weightage of final examination.

## PROMOTION CRITERIA FOR CLASS XI STUDENTS

- Minimum 33% marks in each subject to be declared as '**PASS**'.
- **It is mandatory to pass separately in Both – theory as well as practicals**
- If a student fails to score 33% marks in more than two subjects, he/she will have to repeat the class.
- If a student fails to score 33% marks in any one subject ( As per CBSE Board ) , he/she will have to appear for a re-exam.( School relaxes it to two subjects )
- In case a student fails to score 33% marks in the re-exam, he/she will have to essentially repeat the class. It is mandatory to pass in one / two Retest Exam(s) , the child has appeared for
