



SINCE ITS VERY INCEPTION, SHEF HAS REGARDED THEATRE AS A HARBINGER OF SOCIO-POLITICAL TRANSFORMATION AND A POWERFUL **EMPATHY EDUCATION** THAT **FOSTERS** TOOL OF THROUGH STORYTELLING. RECOGNIZING THE TRANSFORMATIVE POTENTIAL OF THEATRE, SHEF HAS CHAMPIONED IT AS A MEDIUM THAT TRANSCENDS BOUNDARIES, CHALLENGES SOCIAL NORMS, AND SPARKS DIALOGUE ON CRITICAL ISSUES. IN LINE WITH THIS MISSION, AN INTER-SCHOOL DRAMA FESTIVAL, STAGECRAFT, WAS ORGANISED BY STUDY HALL SCHOOL ON AUGUST 3RD AT THE SANT GADGE JI MAHARAJ AUDITORIUM IN GOMTI NAGAR. THE COMPETITION FEATURED SIX EMINENT SCHOOLS FROM THE CITY: LORETO CONVENT, CMS GOMTI NAGAR, SETH MR JAIPURIA, MODERN ACADEMY, VIDYASTHALI, AND THE HOST SCHOOL, STUDY HALL. THE PLAYS CENTRED ON THE THEME OF "RAISING COLLECTIVE CONSCIOUSNESS FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE," REINFORCING FUNDAMENTAL TENETS OF DEMOCRACY AND THE ROLE OF INDIVIDUALS IN PROMOTING AND PROTECTING THESE VALUES. THREE DISTINGUISHED THEATRE CONNOISSEURS JUDGED THE CAPTIVATING PERFORMANCES: MS. KANAK REKHA CHAUHAN, FOUNDER AND DIRECTOR OF THE LUCKNOW AND KANPUR LITERATURE FESTIVALS; DR. MEENAKSHI PAHWA, A RETIRED ENGLISH PROFESSOR FROM LUCKNOW UNIVERSITY; AND MR. FAISAL HUSAIN, A THEATRE ENTHUSIAST AND CREATIVE DIRECTOR OF THE THEATRE GROUP ACTORS. AMIDST SPECIAL INVITEES, PARENTS, AND STUDENTS FROM THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS, THE EVENT REACHED ITS ZENITH WITH THE AWARD CEREMONY. IN ONE OF THE MOST FIERCELY CONTESTED VOLLEYBALL SERIES IN RECENT MEMORY, THE SENIOR SEMI-FINALS AND FINALS TOOK PLACE ON JULY 26TH AND AUGUST 17TH RESPECTIVELY. AFTER THE SEMI-FINAL DRAW, FIREFLAME WAS PAIRED AGAINST CYPRESS, WHILE JACARANDA FACED SILVEROAK. THE SEMI-FINAL BETWEEN CYPRESS AND FIREFLAME WAS A ONE-SIDED AFFAIR, WITH CYPRESS SECURING A COMMANDING 2-0 VICTORY WITH MUCH EASE. ON THE CONTRARY, THE JACARANDA VS. SILVEROAK MATCH WAS A HARD-FOUGHT BATTLE. JACARANDA MANAGED TO WIN THE FIRST SET, BUT SILVEROAK PUT UP A STRONG FIGHT IN THE SECOND. 
